Tuition scholarships are available to AYC members, based on financial need and upon recommendation of the AYC Music Director. The Trustees of the Scholarship Fund make the final decision and distribute the awards.

Should your child receive an Akiyama Scholarship but leave the choir prior to the end of the season he or she will become ineligible for future scholarships unless the scholarship fund is reimbursed for the amount credited to your child's tuition.
